

WG 2, Biometric technical interfaces:

1. Address the standardization of all necessary interfaces and interactions between biometric components and sub-systems, including the possible use of security mechanisms to protect stored data and data transferred between systems.
2. Consider the need for a reference model for the architecture and operation of biometric systems in order to identify the standards that are needed to support multi-vendor systems and their application.
3. Consider, during the development of these standards, the interaction of these standards with other standards under development in other SC 37 WGs.
4. Work with other SC 37 WGs to address inter-related issues of specific projects under development in WG 2 or in another SC 37 WG that might extend across the ToR of the WGs.
5. Identify and enlist the support and participation of experts to promote and progress the objectives and activities of SC 37/WG 2.
6. Serve as a source of expertise in the field of biometric technical interfaces to other WGs of SC37. Support SC 37's goals by responding in a timely fashion to requests pertaining to this area initiated by SC 37, its WGs or other organizations such As JTC 1 SCs, ISO TCs and other SC 37 Liaison organizations.
7. Develop conformance testing methodology standards for the standards developed in WG 2.
