

WG 6, Cross-Jurisdictional and Societal Aspects of Biometrics

1. Address standardization in the field of cross-jurisdictional and societal aspects in the application of ISO/IEC biometrics standards.
 2. Within this context, include the support of design and implementation of biometric technologies with respect to:
 - accessibility
 - health and safety
 - support of legal requirements and acknowledgement of cross jurisdictional and societal considerations pertaining to personal information.
 3. Encourage studies and submissions of new work items in support of cross-jurisdictional and societal aspects.
 4. Develop technical reports or standards for approved projects in support of cross jurisdictional and societal aspects of biometrics.
 5. Identify and enlist the support and participation of experts to promote and progress the objectives and activities of the WG.
 6. Develop NWIP for submission to SC37 for ballot, as needed and appropriate.
 7. Consider, during the development of these standards, the interaction of these standards with other standards under development in other SC 37 WGs.
 8. Serve as a source of expertise in the field of cross-jurisdictional and societal aspects of biometrics to other WGs of SC 37. Support SC 37's goals by responding in a timely fashion to requests pertaining to this area initiated by SC 37, its WGs or other organizations such as JTC 1 SCs, ISO TCs and other SC 37 Liaison organizations.
1. address the standardization of testing and reporting methodologies and metrics that cover biometric technologies, systems and components
 2. encourage studies and submissions of new work items related to biometric testing and reporting and related issues
 3. identify and enlist the support and participation of experts to promote and progress the objectives and activities of SC 37/WG 5
 4. consider, during the development of these standards, the interaction of these standards with other standards under development in other SC 37 WGs
 5. work in collaboration with other SC 37 WGs to address inter-related issues of specific projects under development in WG 5 or in another SC 37 WG that might extend across the terms of reference of the WGs
 6. Serve as a source of expertise in the field of biometric testing and reporting to other WGs of SC 37
 7. Support SC 37's goals by responding in a timely fashion to requests pertaining to this area initiated by SC 37, its WGs or other organizations such as JTC 1 SCs, ISO TCs and other SC 37 Liaison organizations.
 8. where appropriate, develop conformance testing methodology standards
